一村又一圈展後展説的是一個關於在城內游走的故事。2008年4月13日,50個好奇的搭客分坐兩輛巴士,去了四個相距不近的地方,看一天長並無從預料的藝術展覽、音樂演奏和演出。旅程由樂富開始,在港島南結束,在香港獨特的地貌當中探索了一些地方。透過旅程所有參與者和旅客提供的照片、錄像和物件,這次旅程的故事得以重述。

FOLKTALES FROM MANY LANDS exhibition tells a story about a journey around the city. On April 13, 2008 two buses with 50 curious passengers were taken on a ride to four remote locations for an unexpected day of art, music and performances. From Lok Fu to the South Hong Kong Island, the journey explores places throughout the unique landscapes of Hong Kong. The story of the journey is retold through photographs, videos and artifacts from all participants and travelers of the trip. Folktales From Many Lands is included as part 2 of the Hong Kong Is Our Museum project.

HONG KONG IS OUR MUSEUM is an open platform for visual art and discourse devised by Map Office (Laurent Gutierrez and Valerie Portefaix) and Prof. Norman Ford. It enables non-traditional production and exhibition with a focus on the urban/rural spaces of Hong Kong and leveraging an inherently lean infrastructure. HKIOM is therefore a platform for creating and showing art outside conventional venues, exploiting chance, site specificity, networks and relationships, not bound to the state, institutions or funding bodies.
